Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) Situational Report

Report No.036 Date of Issue: 5th May, 2020, 11.am GMT

- As at 5th May 2020, there were 199 confirmed COVID-19 cases, 11 deaths and 43 recoveries in Sierra Leone
- Twenty-one new confirmed COVID-19 cases, two deaths and six recoveries were reported in the last 24 hours
- Eight out of sixteen districts are affected.
- Case Fatality Rate (CFR) is 5.5% *
- The three-day nationwide lockdown ends today. Interdistrict travel restrictions and curfew remain in place





Figure 1: Reported COVID-19 cases in Sierra Leone as at 5th May, 2020

- Since the first case of COVID-19 was confirmed on 30th March, 2020, the magnitude of the outbreak has increased and the outbreak has spread to **eight** out of sixteen **districts**
- Ninety-five cases have been reported in the last 7 days
- Most cases are contacts of confirmed cases






Figure 2: Age-Sex Distribution and Outcome of COVID-19 Cases


Figure 3: Age-Specific Case Fatality Rates

- Median Age of cases is 35 years (Range 2 months -76 years)
- One hundred and eleven (55.8%) are male
- One hundred and thirty-five (67.8%) cases are aged 15-44 years
- Total deaths are eleven including nine males and two females
- Case fatality rate increases with age and is highest (33.3%) among cases aged >60 years

- Half (8 out of 16) of the districts have reported COVID-19 Cases
- Highest incidence* is in Western Area Urban- 11.4 / 100,000 population
- National incidence is 2.6 /100,000

 st Incidence based on confirmed cases. Low proportion of the population has been tested for COVID-19. Incidence is likely an underestimate
