- Maternal death: Three (3) maternal deaths were reported from Karene (2), Port Loko (1) district


Week 47: 21st — 27th Nov,2022

- Measles: Twenty-five (25) cases of suspected Measles were reported this week. Of the cases, twenty were under fives and five were above five years of age. The highest number of cases were from WAU (16), Port Loko (5), WAR (3). The cases were investigated and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation
- Yellow Fever: One (1) case of suspected Yellow Fever was reported this week. The case was above five years of age from WAR. The case was investigated and sample sent to CPHRL for confirmation
- Acute Viral Hemorrhagic Fever (AVHF): Two (2) cases of suspected AVHF with one death was reported from Tonkolili this week. The cases were above five years of age. The cases were investigated and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation



Health Facility Completeness and Timeliness of Weekly report by district, (Epi week 47, 2022)




For week 47, a total of 15 districts achieved both the WHO and national target for timeliness and completeness, while one met the target for completeness but couldn't meet both targets for timeliness

Compared Laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases reported by district (Week 1 - 47, 2021 & 2022)



Confirmed COVID-19 cases reported by sex (Week 1 – 47, 2021 & 2022)




Positivity rate of COVID-19 confirmed cases (Epi Week 1 - 47, 2022)







Cumulative Animal Bite (Dog) cases reported by districts (Epi Week 1 - 47, 2021 & 2022)





Port Loko and Pujehun district have reported one death each due to clinical Rabies

Cumulative Animal bite (Snake) reported by districts (Epi Week 1 - 47, 2021 & 2022)




For week 47 of 2022, a total of eighteen (18) snake bites were reported from nine districts. The districts that have recorded higher numbers of snake bites are Bombali, Koinadugu, Karene, Kenema, Tonkolili, Kailahun, Moyamba, Port Loko, Pujehun and Kambia district. The cumulative total since the start of the year is 510 countrywide. Twenty deaths due to snake bites have been reported from Bombali, Port Loko and Tonkolili (3) each per districts, Karene, Kenema and Pujehun (2) each and Bo, Bonthe, Kambia, Kono and Moyamba (1) each per districts
