#### Disease specific report

- Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP): Five (5) cases of AFP were reported this
  week all aged under five years from Kailahun (3), Moyamba and WAU
  (1) each per district. The cases were investigated and samples sent to
  CPHRL for confirmatory shipment
- Animal Bite (Dog): Twenty-one (21) Dog bite cases were reported this
  week all aged above five years. The highest number of cases were
  from Kono (6), Bombali (4), WAR (2)
- Animal Bite (Snake): Twenty-two (22) Snake bite cases with one death
  was reported this week from Port Loko. Of the cases, eight were under
  five and fourteen were above five years. The highest number of cases
  were from Koinadugu (10), Bombali (9)
- Maternal death: Six (6) maternal death were reported from Tonkolili and WAU (2) each, Kambia and Koinadugu (1) each per district
- Measles: Sixty- five (65) cases of suspected Measles with one death
  was reported this week. Of the cases, fifty- three were under fives and
  twelve were above five years of age. The highest number of cases were
  from WAU (33), Port Loko (10), WAR (9), . The cases were investigated
  and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation
- Yellow Fever: Two (2) suspected cases of Yellow Fever were reported this week all aged above five years from Kailahun and Port Loko (1). The cases were investigated and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation


#### Week 12: 20th — 26th March, 2023

- Acute Viral Hemorrhagic Fever (AVHF): Two (2) cases of suspected AVHF with one death reported from WAU this week.
   Of the cases, five-three were under five and twelve were above five years of age. The cases were investigated and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation
- **Bacterial Meningitis:** One (1) case of suspected Meningitis was reported from WAU this week all aged under five. The case was investigated and sample sent to CPHRL for confirmation

## Health Facility Timeliness & Completeness of Weekly report by district, (Epi week 12, 2023)




## **Key highlights on COVID-19 Surveillance updates** (Epi Week 12, 2023)

- 0 recovered reported: (Source: DHIS2 eCBDS)


# COVID-19 test conducted by sex (Epi Week 51 – 52, 2022 & Epi Week 1 - 12, 2023) N=7730



# Positivity rate of COVID-19 confirmed cases (Epi Week 1 - 12, 2023)




For week 12 of 2023 one confirmed COVID-19 case was reported countrywide giving the positivity rate of 2% of the total test conducted





### Cumulative Dog Bite cases reported by district (Epi Week 1 - 12, 2023)




For week 12 of 2023, twenty-one Dog bite cases were reported from twelve districts. The cumulative number of cases country-wide is 256. The districts of Koinadugu, Kono, Bombali, Kailahun, Kenema, Pujehun, Moyamba, WAU, Bonthe and Port Loko, have reported higher numbers of Dog bite cases.

## Cumulative Snake Bite cases reported by district (Epi Week 1 - 12, 2023)



For week 12 of 2023, a total of twenty-two (22) snake bites reported from five districts. The districts that have recorded higher numbers of snake bites are Kono, Bombali, Koinadugu, Port Loko, Kenema, Karena and Pujehun district. The cumulative total since the start of the year is 128 countrywide.

# Cumulative Maternal Death reported by district (Epi Week 1 - 12, 2023)



For week 12 of 2023, six maternal death were reported from four districts. The cumulative deaths since the start of the year is 103 countrywide.


