Disease specific report

- Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP): Four (4) cases of AFP were reported this
 week all aged under five years from Kailahun, Karene, Port Loko and
 Pujehun (1) each per district. The cases were investigated and samples
 sent to CPHRL for confirmatory shipment
- Animal Bite (Dog): Twenty-six (26) Dog bite cases were reported this
 week. Of the cases three were under five and twenty-three were
 above five years. The highest number of cases were from Kono (10),
 Pujehun and WAR (3), Bombali and Kailahun (2) each per district
- Animal Bite (Snake): Fourteen (14) Snake bite cases were reported
 this week. Of the cases, three were under five and eleven were above
 fives years. The highest number of cases were from Bombali (5), Port
 Loko and WAR (2) each per district
- Maternal death: Three (3) maternal death were reported from Kenema,
 WAR and WAU (1) each per district
- Measles: Thirty—three (33) cases of suspected Measles were reported
 this week. Of the cases, thirty—one were under fives and two were
 above five years of age. The highest number of cases were from WAU
 (17), WAR (7), Port Loko (6). The cases were investigated and samples
 sent to CPHRL for confirmation
- Yellow Fever: One (1) suspected cases of Yellow Fever was reported this
 week aged under five years from Kailahun. The cases were investigated
 and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation


Week 15: 10th April — 16th April, 2023

- Acute Viral Hemorrhagic Fever (AVHF): Five (5) cases of suspected AVHF were reported this week. All the cases were aged under five years. The cases were investigated and samples sent to CPHRL for confirmation
- Bacterial Meningitis: Three (3) cases of suspected Meningitis were reported from WAU this week all aged under five. No sample was collected for laboratory confirmation.

Health Facility Timeliness & Completeness of Weekly report by district, (Epi week 15, 2023)




Key highlights on COVID-19 Surveillance updates (Epi Week 15, 2023)


COVID-19 test conducted by sex (Epi Week 51 – 52, 2022 & Week 1 - 15, 2023) N=7730



Positivity rate of COVID-19 confirmed cases (Epi Week 1 - 52, 2022)




For week 15 of 2023 no confirmed COVID-19 case was reported countrywide. The positivity rate has been fluctuating over the past eight weeks





Cumulative Dog Bite cases reported by district (Epi Week 1 - 15, 2023)




For week 15 of 2023, twenty-six Dog bite cases were reported from eleven districts. The cumulative number of cases country-wide is 312. The districts of Koinadugu, Kono, Bombali, Kailahun, Kenema, Pujehun, Moyamba, WAU, Bonthe and Port Loko, have reported higher numbers of Dog bite cases.

Cumulative Snake Bite cases reported by district (Epi Week 1 - 15, 2023)



For week 15 of 2023, a total of fourteen (14) snake bites reported from eight districts. The districts that have recorded higher numbers of snake bites are Kono, Bombali, Koinadugu, Port Loko, Kenema, Karena and Pujehun district. The cumulative total since the start of the year is 143 countrywide.

Cumulative Maternal Death reported by district (Epi Week 1 - 15, 2023)



For week 15 of 2023, three maternal death were reported from seven districts. The cumulative deaths since the start of the year is 122 countrywide.


