**UPDATED TRAVEL ADVISORY FOR INBOUND PASSENGERS**

Following a review of the Sierra Leone Travel Advisory, the following changes have been made with immediate effect:

1. All persons intending to travel to Sierra Leone SHALL produce a negative PCR COVID-19 Test Result issued no later than seven (7) days to date of travel. The advisory does not state that passengers must get tested within seven days to travel; but insists that the result is issued by a competent laboratory within the stipulated period i.e. having a 7 days validity period.
2. Passengers whose stay in the country will not exceed five (5) days, do not require to be tested before leaving the country. However, they are required to request for a certificate of the negative PCR test result that was administered to them when they arrived in Sierra Leone.
