PUBLIC NOTICE

NaCOVERC wishes to inform the general public that we are in the 35th week of the Coronavirus outbreak in Sierra Leone, and notes with cautious satisfaction the listing of Sierra Leone by the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as a low-risk country.

The public would recall that on 26th October, the curfew from 11pm to 5am was lifted for a period of four (4) weeks, subject to review. Following this review, NaCOVERC wishes to announce **that the curfew continues to be lifted until such time when it would be otherwise advised.**

The public is advised to continue the proper wearing of face masks in public; regular hand washing as well as social distancing, which have proven to be effective public health tools.

As we approach the festive season, we advise members of the public to celebrate the holidays responsibly and stay away from crowded events. In this vein, **anyone wishing to organize a large-scale event should contact NaCOVERC for assessment of the proposed event and determination of its guidance and decision.**

We have enhanced our vigilance at our airports and mainland border entry points to ensure that no new Covid-19 case is allowed into our communities. We appeal to all and sundry to cooperate with NaCOVERC to achieve this critical goal in the interest of us all.

Our nation is extremely grateful to all the dedicated and patriotic men and women who work on a daily basis and having sleepless nights just to keep COVID-19 in check. Let us continue to have them in our prayers.

Let us similarly remember the 74 souls that have succumbed to the coronavirus disease. May their memories be blessed, and their souls rest in eternal peace.
