Freetown 9th February, 2022

The public would recall that two days ago, the new NaCOVERC Chairman Dr. Amara Jambai, made a commitment to start payment of backlogs to affected COVID-19 health workers this week.

Consistent with that promise, NaCOVERC is pleased to report that payment instructions have been sent to relevant banks (and will include risk allowance for January 2022).

For this first tranche, workers in the Case Management Pillar have been prioritized. Affected workers in other pillars will soon start benefitting from this action.

All affected workers are asked to continue exercising patience, as payments towards liquidation of the backlog will be made as funds are allocated to the Response by the central Government.

Next week, NaCOVERC will review this first phase of implementation of backlog payments, and indicate to the pillar representatives about further payments.

NaCOVERC reiterates its commitment to honour contractual obligations, and continues to solicit restraint, as the new Chairman Dr. Amara Jambai has shown compelling resolve to having this long-drawn matter addressed.
